

Tool and Equipment Guidelines

A cooperating ranger must approve use and operation of all tools and equipment on park property during the project.

Hand tools borrowed from Crowders Mountain State Park must be reserved *at least* one week in advance. Arrangements for borrowing these tools are to be made with the cooperating ranger.

Chainsaws, gas drills and other gas-powered equipment can only be operated on park property by qualified park staff.

Tractors, utility vehicles, dump trucks, and other heavy equipment can only be operated on park property by qualified park staff.

Paperwork Guidelines

The North Carolina Division of Parks and Recreation requires that the following volunteer paperwork be completed *prior* to starting the volunteer project:

Agreement for Volunteer Services (Form V-3) for all adult leaders and adult volunteers.

Agreement for Volunteer Services (Form V-3) and *Parental Approval Form* (Form V-3b) for all volunteers under the age of eighteen.

List of Volunteer Group Participants (Form V-3a).

Volunteer Job Description (Form V-1).

The North Carolina Division of Parks and Recreation requires that the following volunteer paperwork be completed at the end of the volunteer work assignment:
